

## Can I import tracks and points into Locus Map?

Of course you can and again, it's simple. Do you track your sports activity in **Endomondo**? Do you plan your trips on **Bikemap.net** and want to display them in **Locus Map**?

Export your tracks into **GPX** format, copy them to your phone and select **Import data** in your Locus Map  $\equiv$  Main Menu.

Find the desired gpx file, tap it and Locus Map will ask you what **folder** you want to store your track to. Either choose an existing one or make a **new one**.

Tap **Import** and there you go! Your track appears on the map neatly centered on your screen.
