



## How to place a point of interest on the map?

### BTW, what is a point of interest, a.k.a. POI?




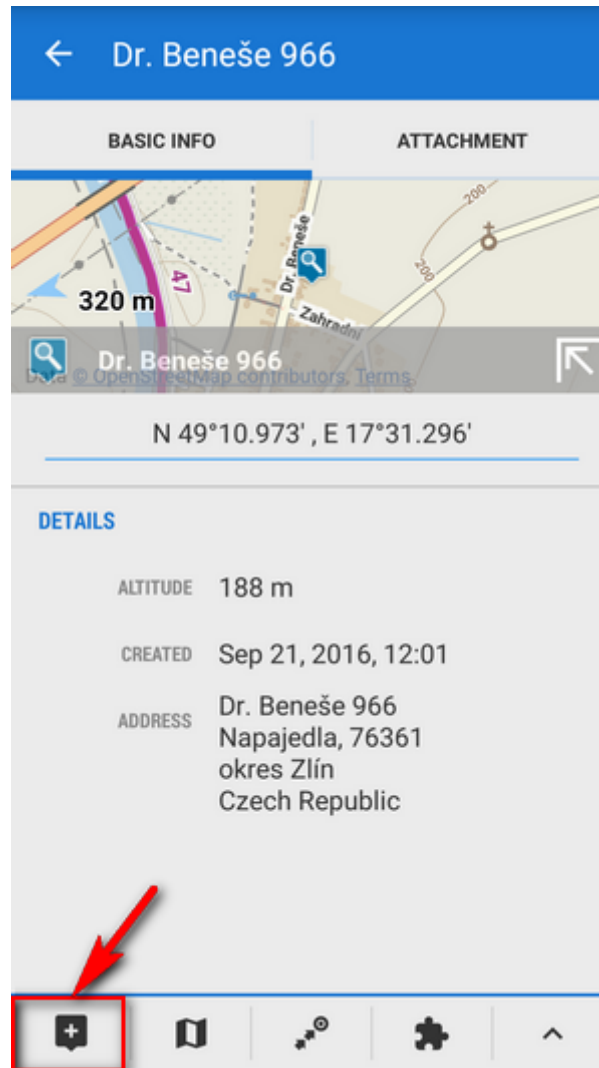
POIs are places on the map that carry some more information you are interested in. **Just tap them.** Usually they describe things like **monuments, theaters, museums, pubs, hotels** etc.

**Locus Map** allows you to place **your own POI** to mark anything you like on your trip, to show your friends your address on holidays or to let yourself navigate to it. It's simple:

- **1.** touch the screen on the place you'd like to save and hold a sec. A small frame with address appears. **2.** tap it once more to open the POI detail window.




- tap  in the left lower corner.



- edit name of your point or just leave what is in the place of name and tap **Save**.
